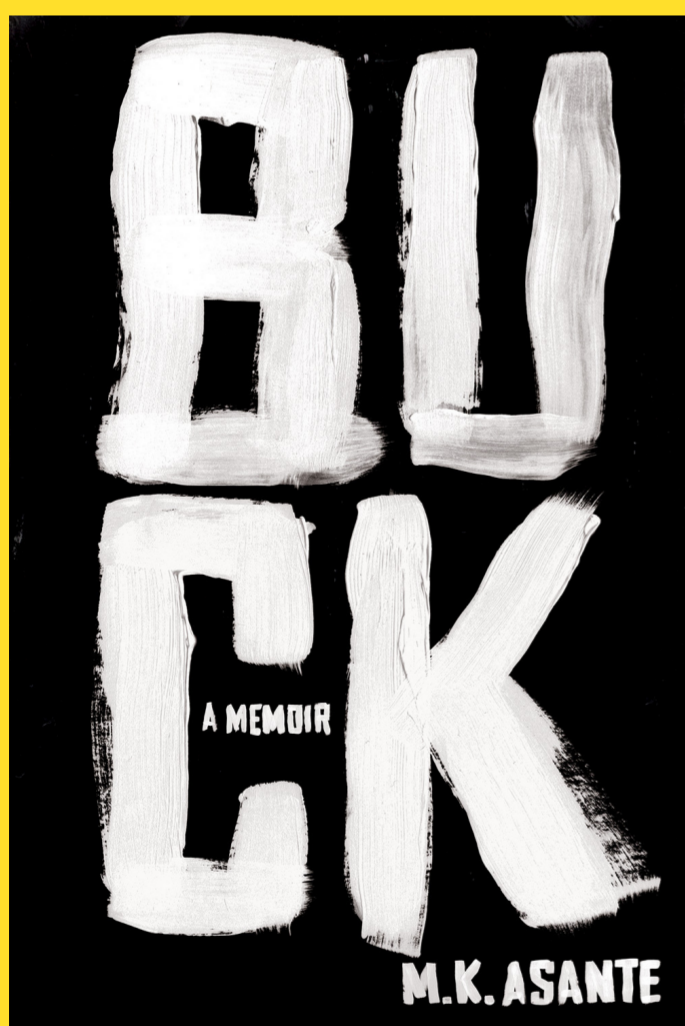
EXPLORING RACE, IDENTITY AND FAMILY THROUGH THE VOICES OF AFRICAN AMERICAN YOUTH
